Publication ethics and malpractice policy

- International Journal of Engineering Sciences (IJES) is devoted to publish original and genuine research work. Hence, the authors who submit their work for publication must ensure that their submissions are based on their own research work.
- This must be ensured that authors of publications present the results of their work in a clear, reliable and honest manner regardless of the fact whether they are the direct authors of publication or they took help from any specialist/legal person.
- Providing clear information about any party that contributed in preparation of a publication is ethical practice, which must be followed by a researcher.
- Authors must duly acknowledge by giving full reference of any information taken from other resources in their writing.
- Authors must follow **anti-plagiarism** practice in preparation of manuscript of their research paper. They must not copy any part of other writings as it is in their research paper, which violates copyright of others.
- **Ghostwriting** and **guest authorship** must be avoided.
- To ensure the accuracy of the published information, editorial team of IJES takes action to counter unethical practices.
- The journal mentions clearly in the “Guide for authors” that all cases of scientific dishonesty, following any unethical practice will be exposed, and adequate institutions will be informed about it.
- The editorial office asks authors to disclose contribution of individual authors to preparation of a publication in detail like author of concept, objectives, methods, etc., used in the publication. Main responsibility to disclose full information lies with the author submitting manuscript (Corresponding Author).
- The editorial office also asks for information on sources of financing of a publication, financial contributions of research institutions.

As an action to counter unethical practices, the authors are obliged to fill ‘*Author's contribution and declaration*’ form available on the journal's webpage and send scanned copy of the signed original to the Secretary to the Editor (secretary@scmrglobal.org).
